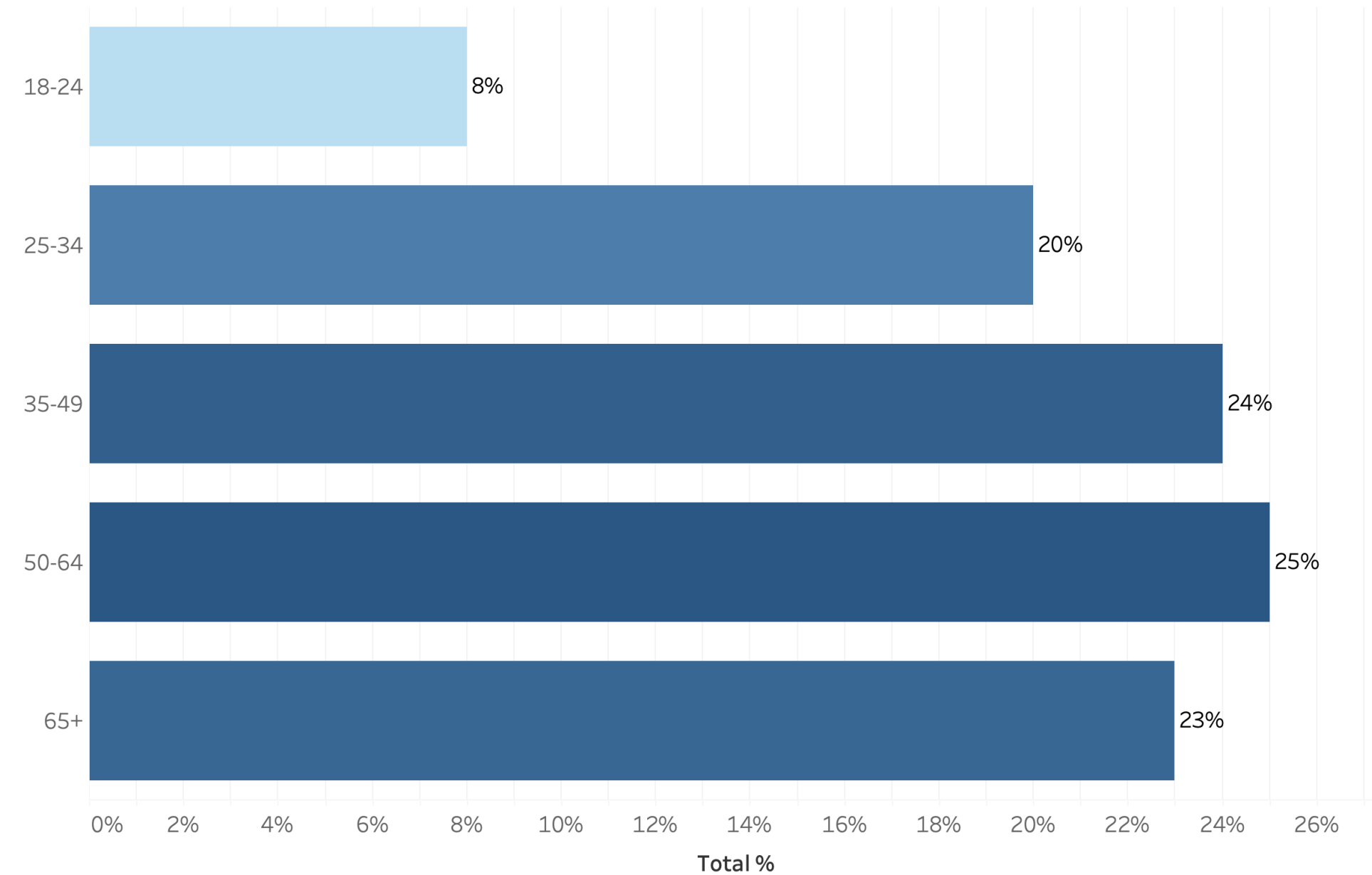


TEXAS HOUSE DISTRICT 100 POLLING

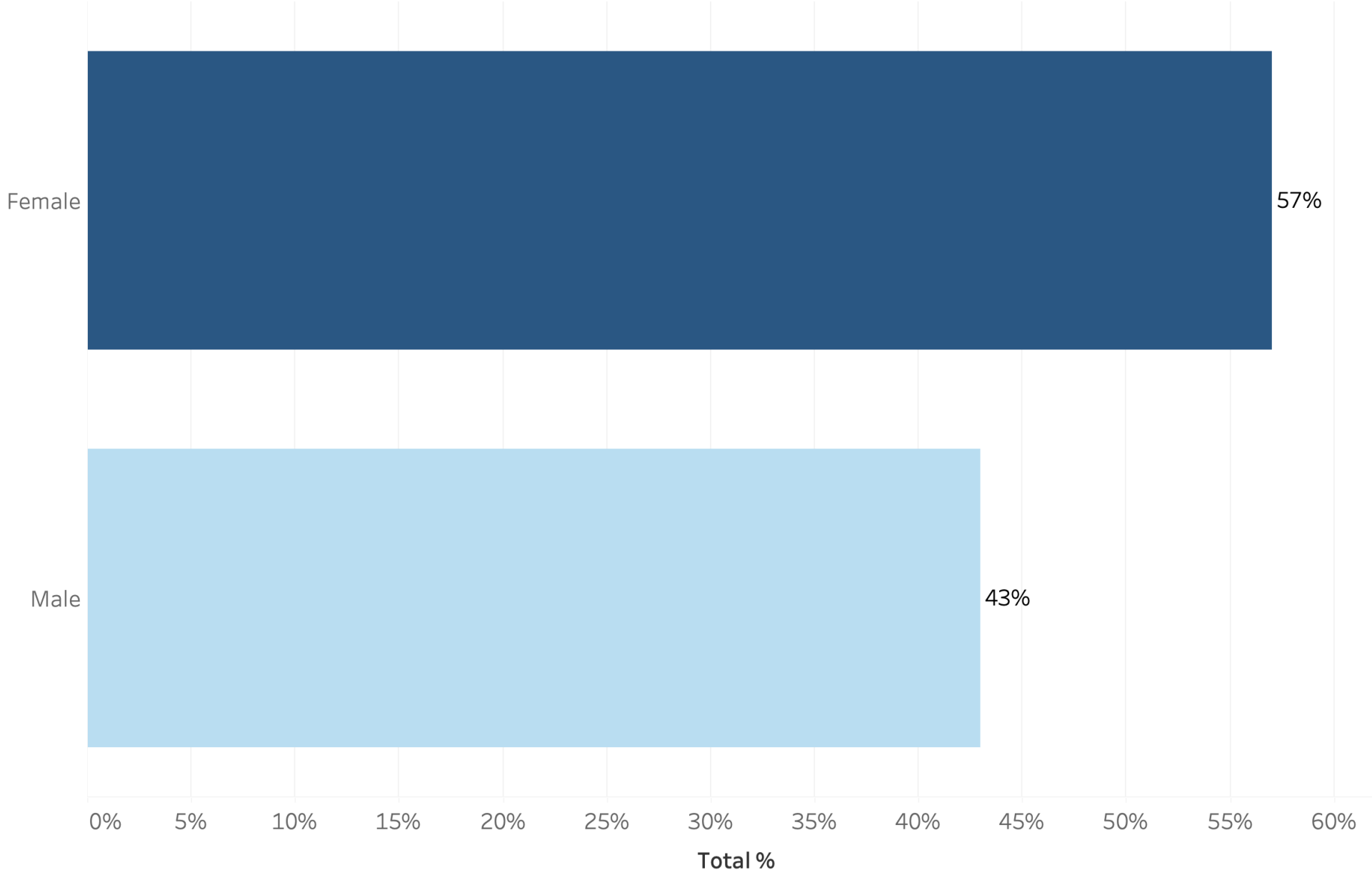

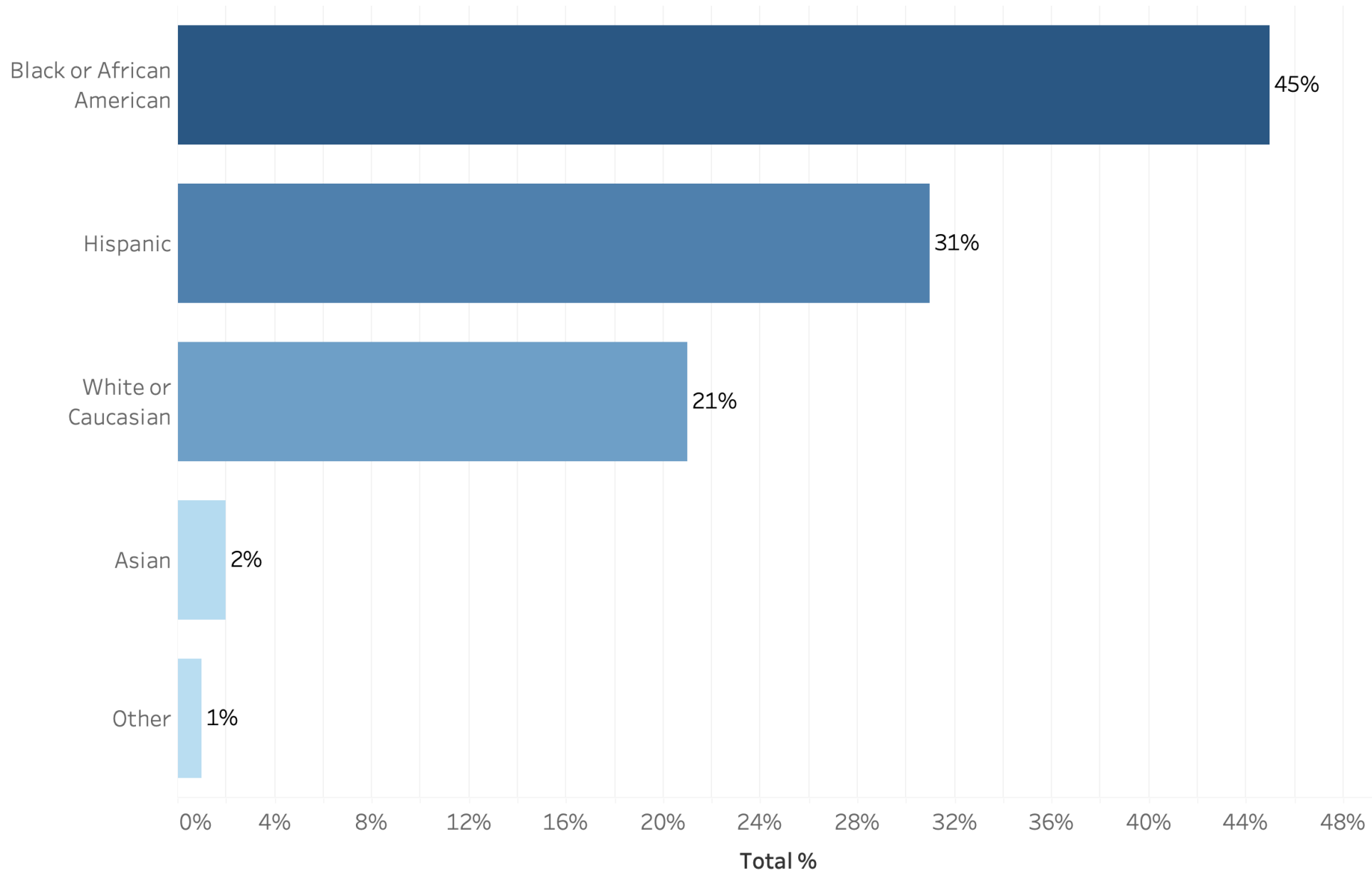
Age Demographic



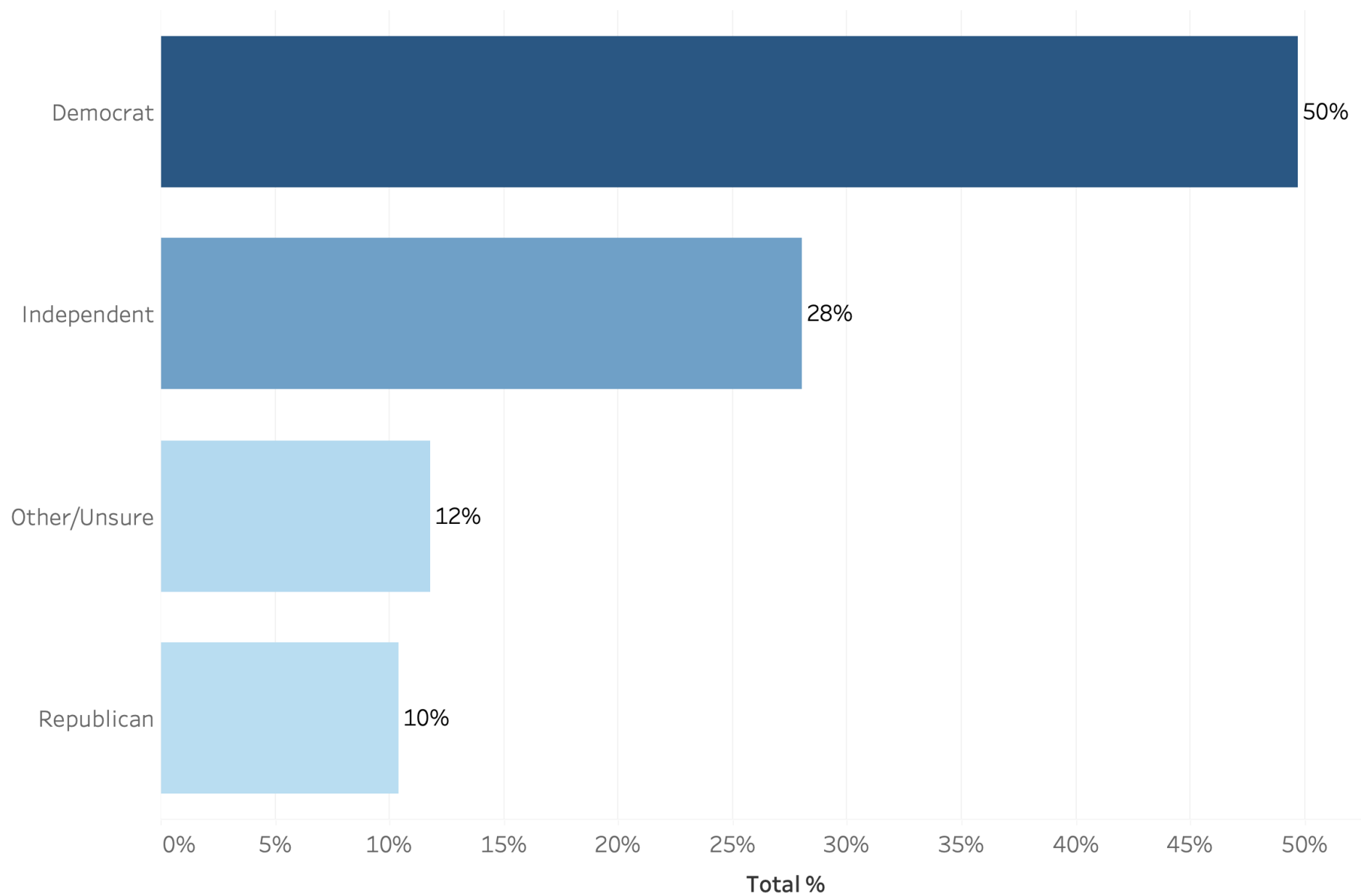
Gender Demographic



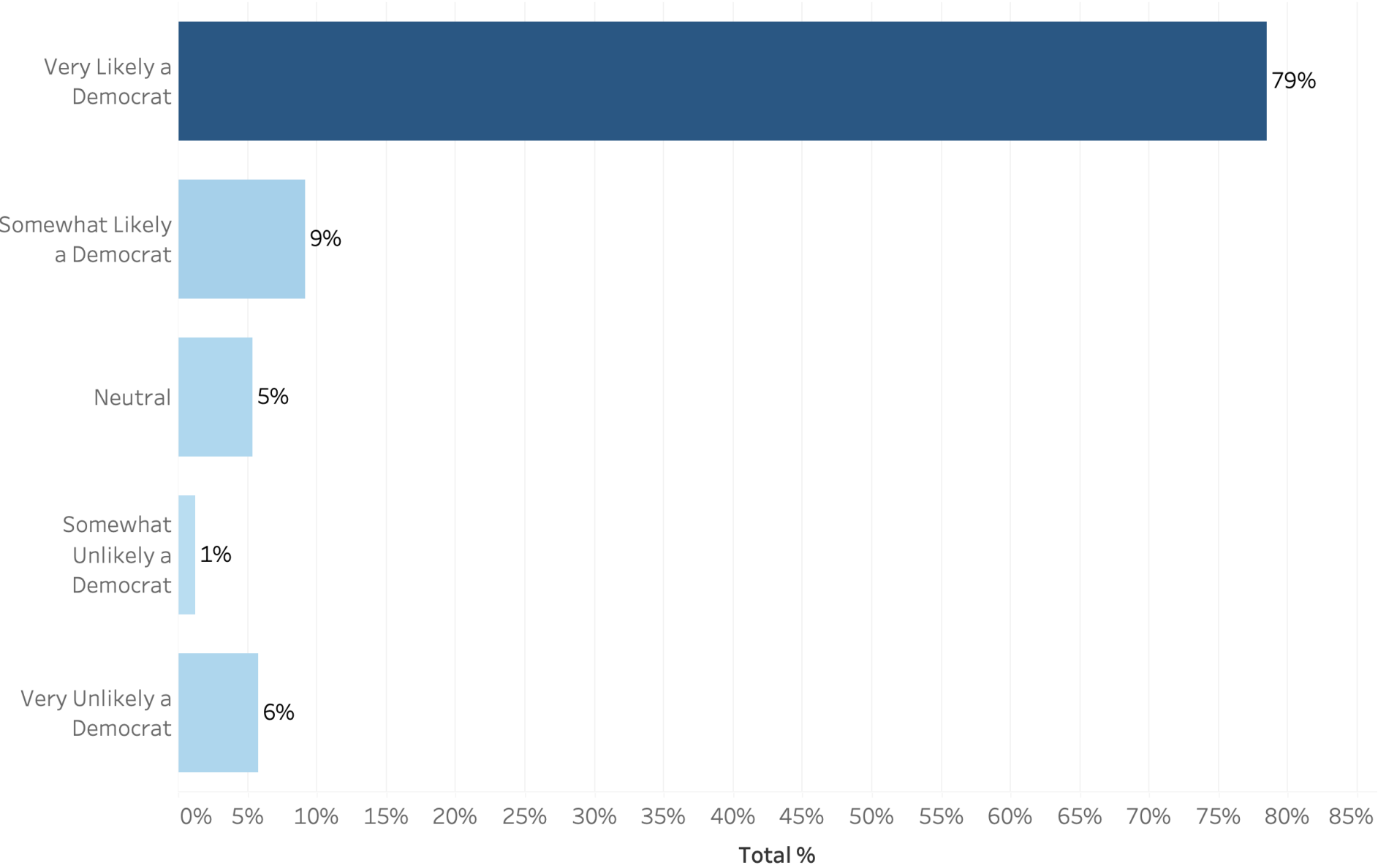
Race Demographic



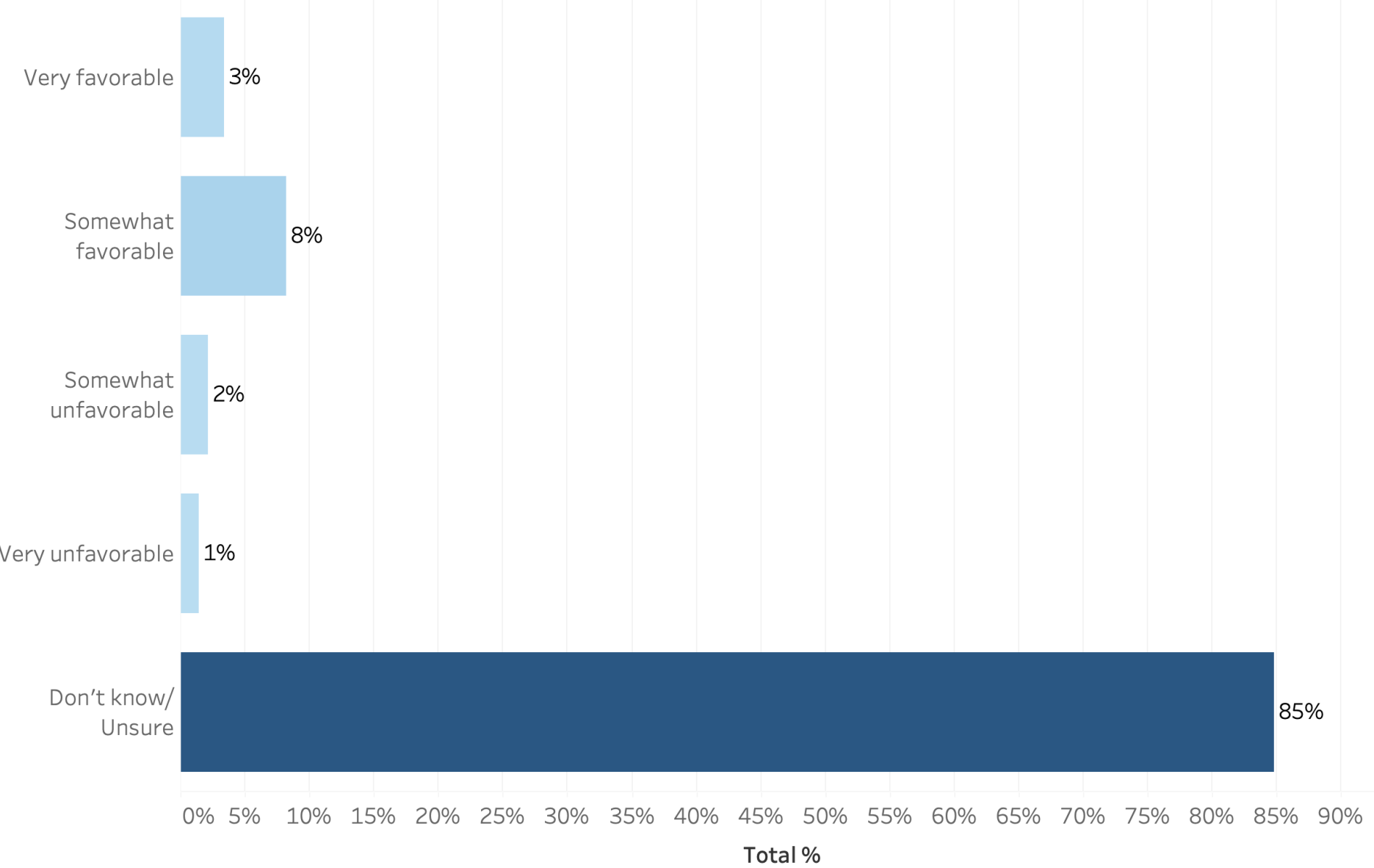
Do you consider yourself a Democrat, Republican, or Independent?



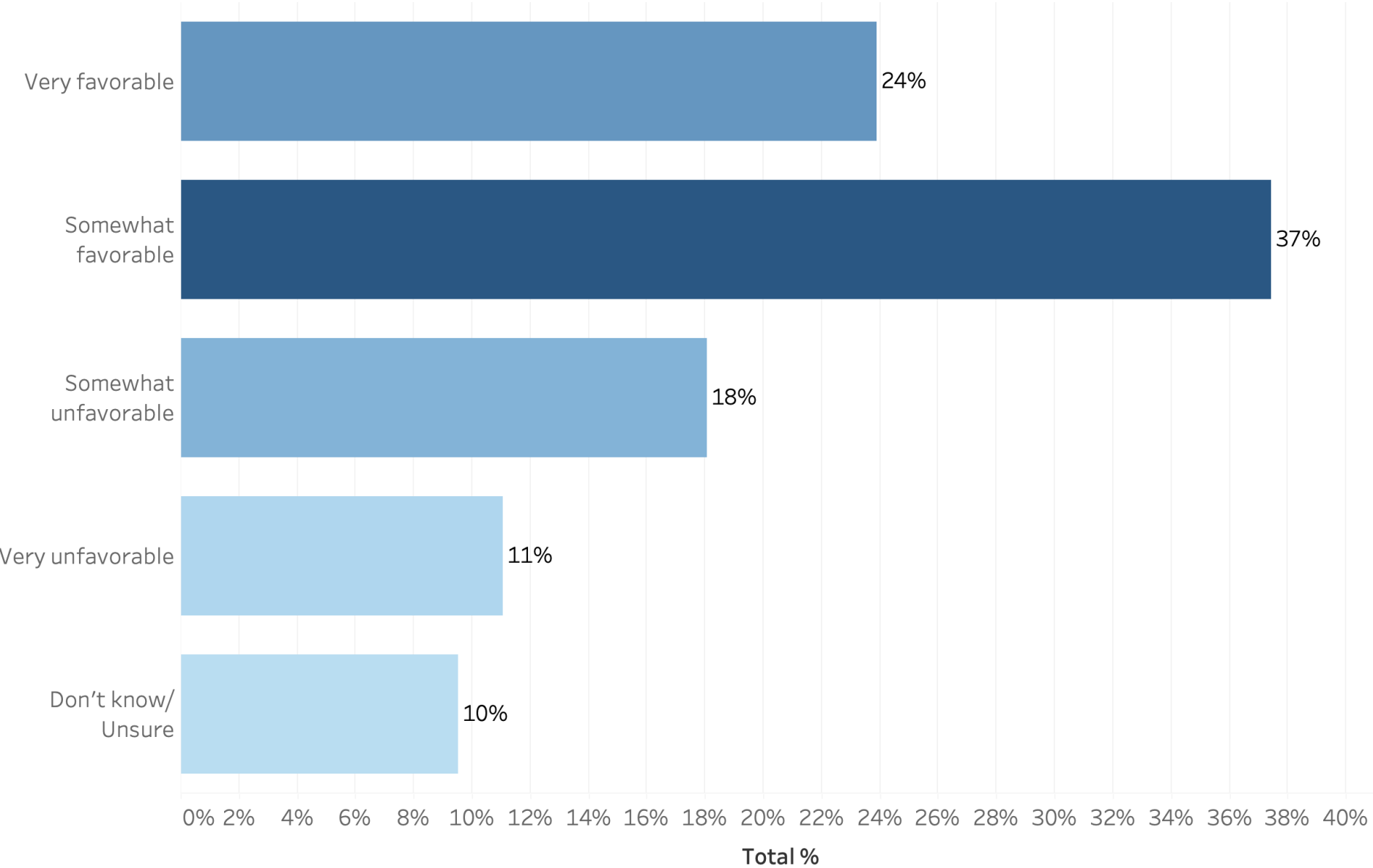
Model: Likelihood of being a Democrat?



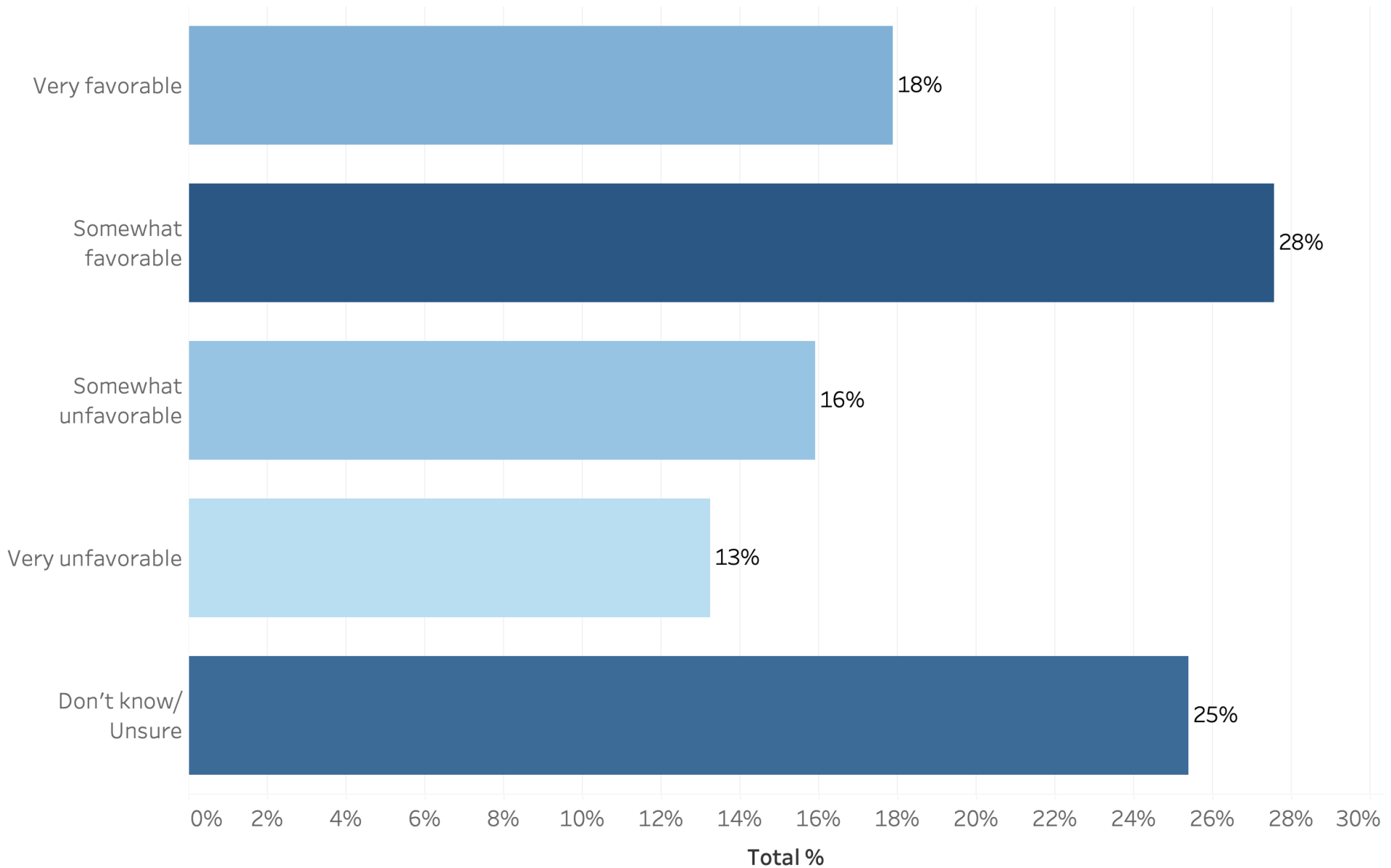
Favorability: State Representative Venton Jones



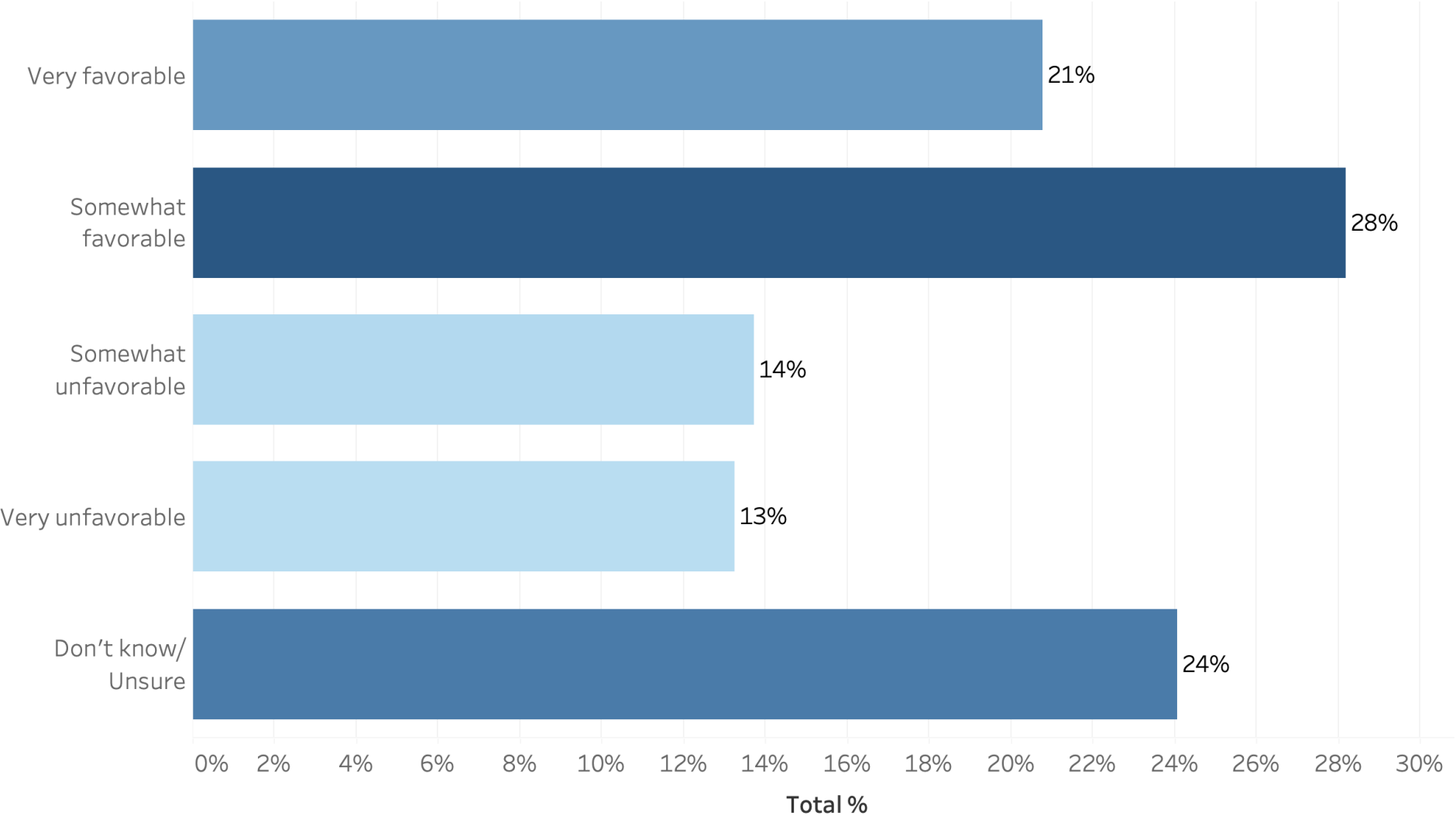
Favorability: Texas Public Schools



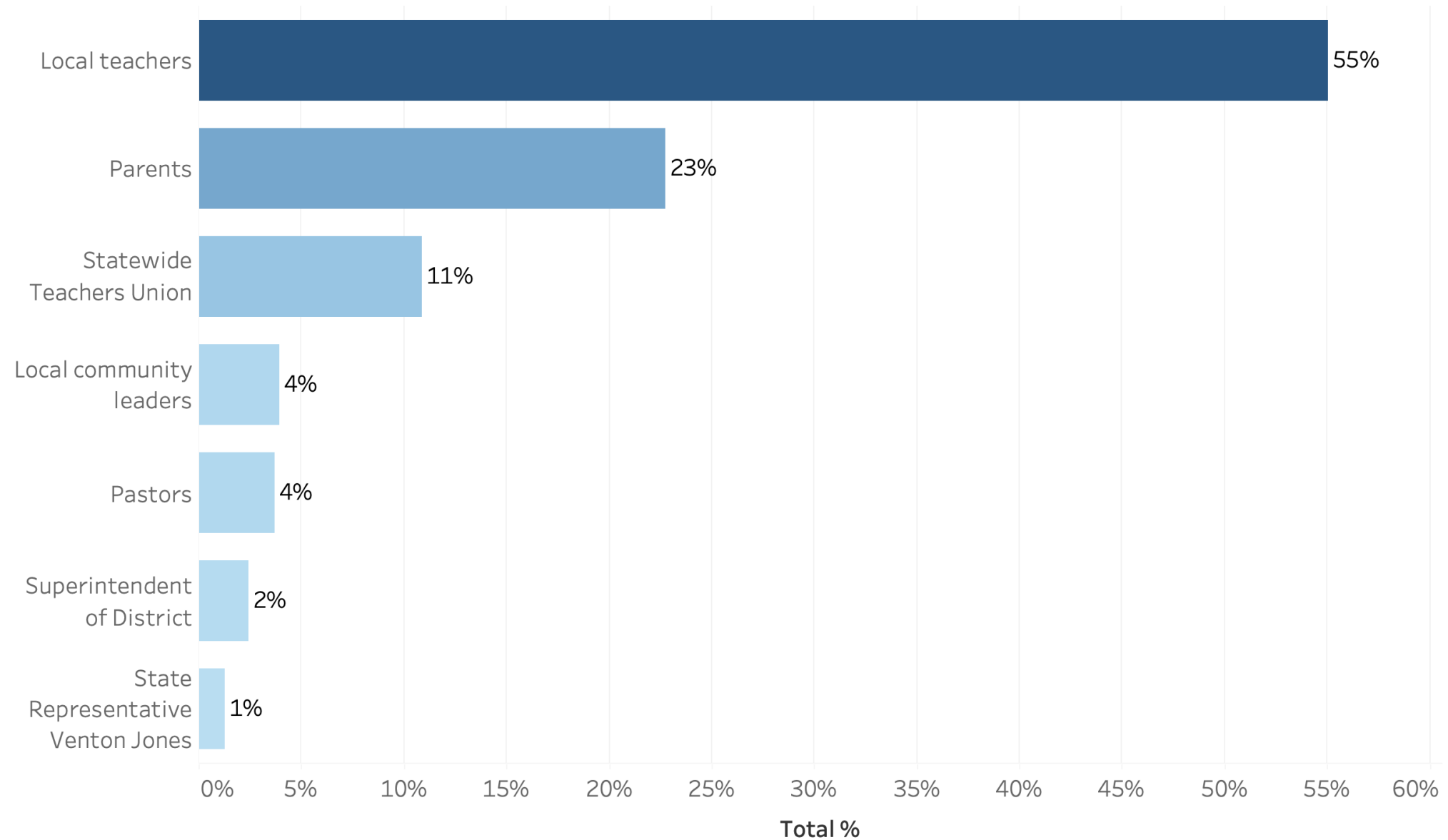
Favorability: Texas Non-Profit Public Charter Schools



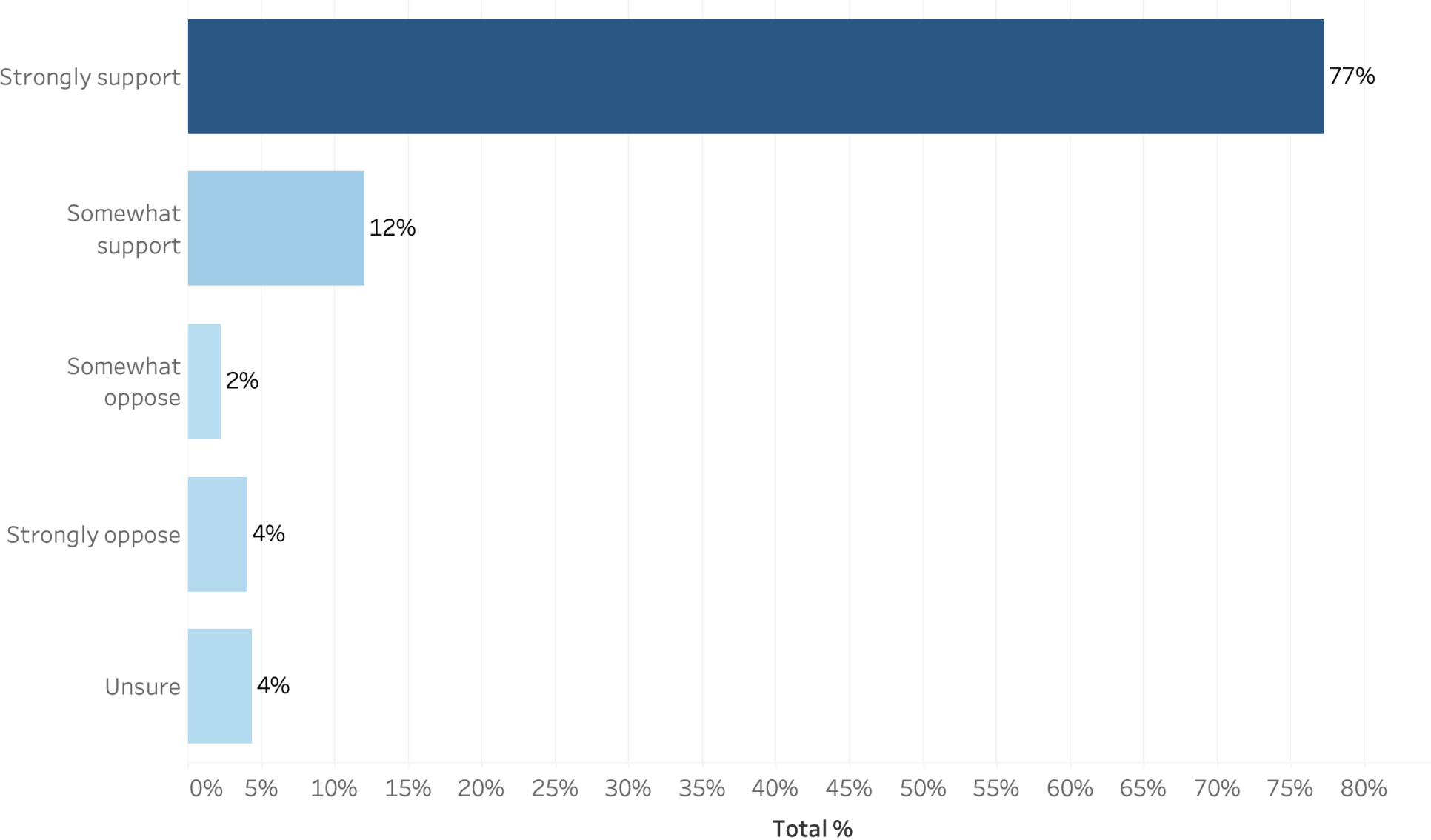
Favorability: Sometimes during a survey like this people change their minds, sometimes they do not. Do you have a favorable or unfavorable impression of Texas Public Charter Schools?



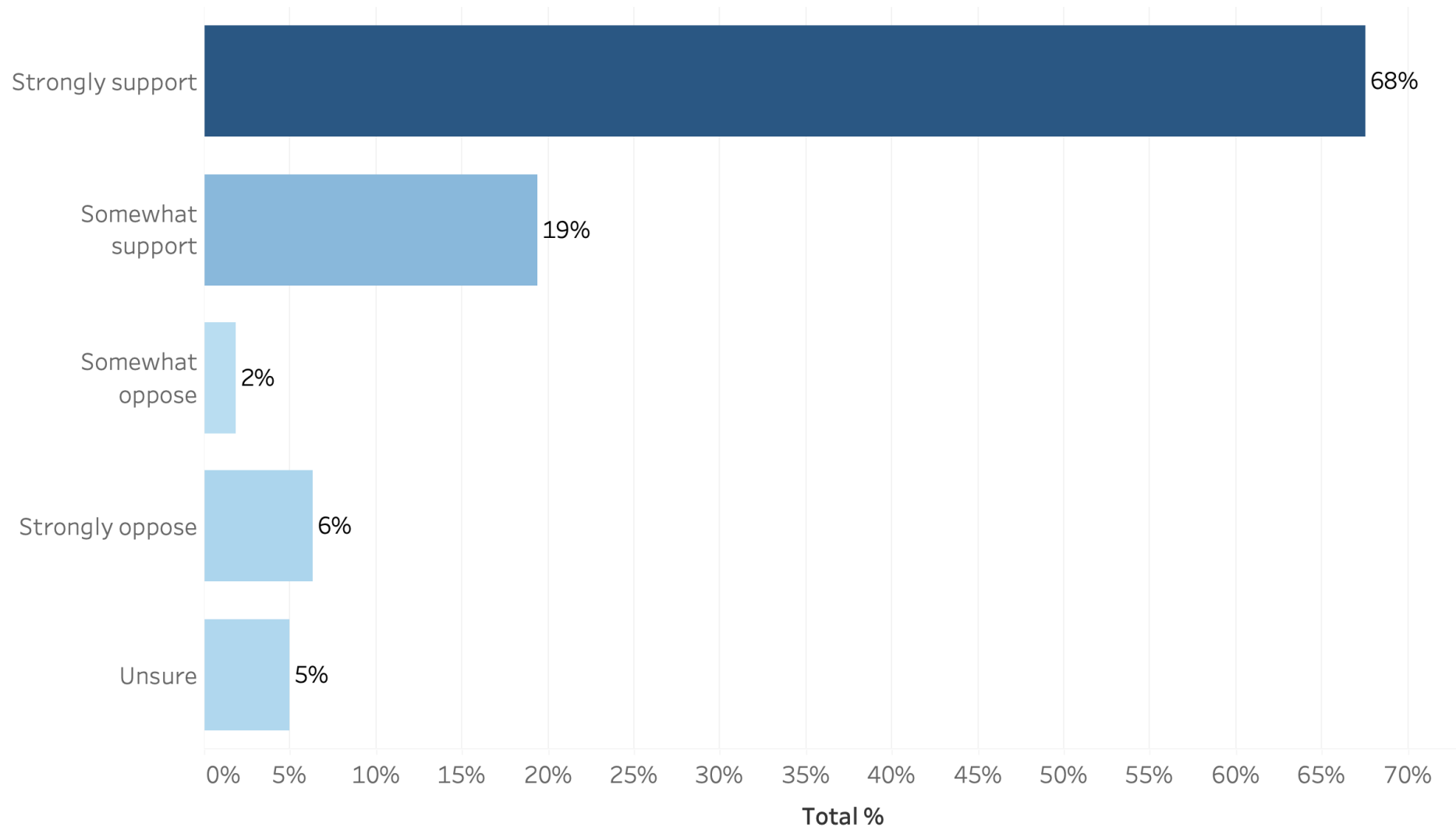
When it comes to issues related to education and schools, whom do you trust most?



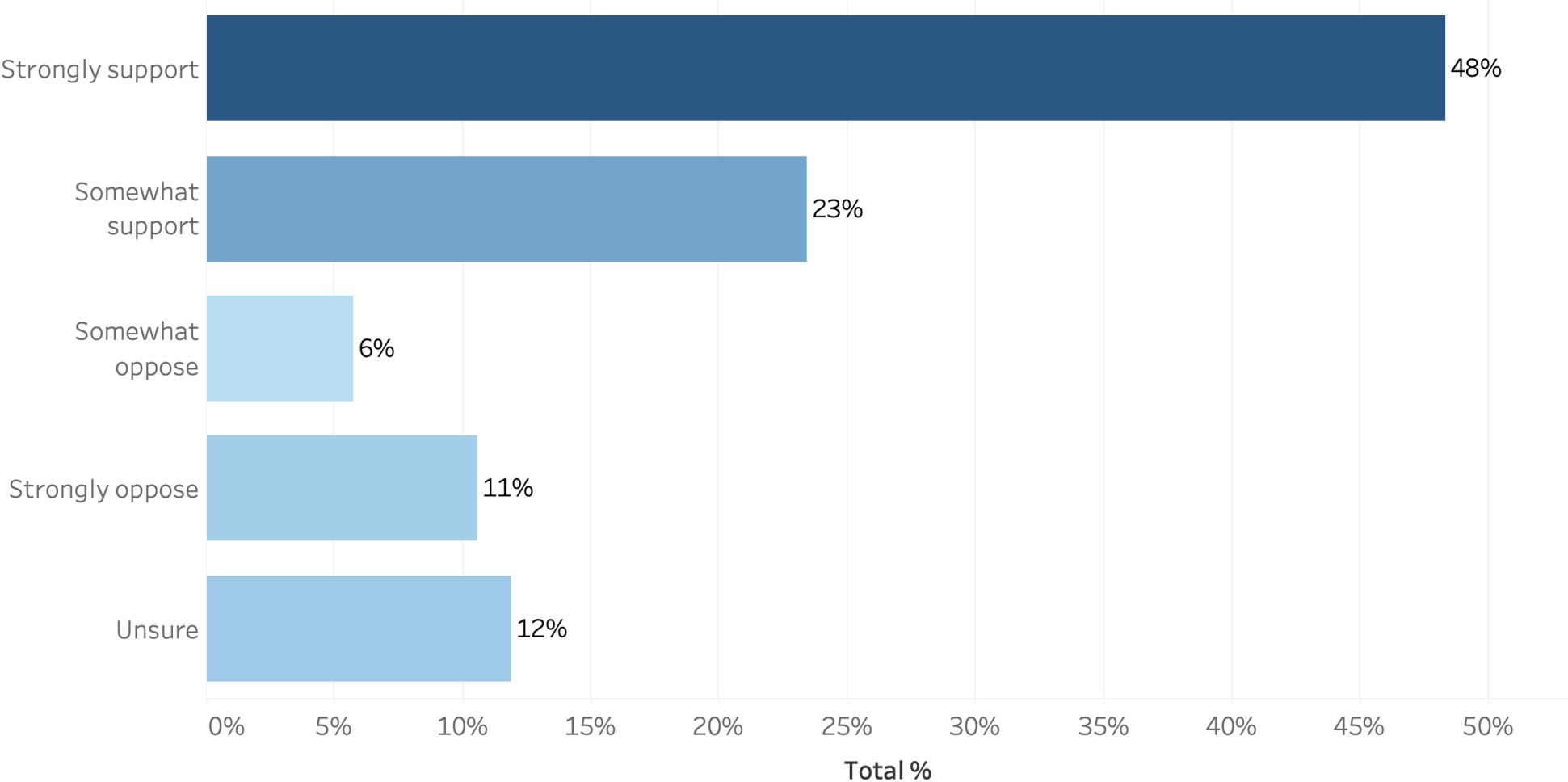
Do you support a measure that would increase funding for all public schools in Texas?



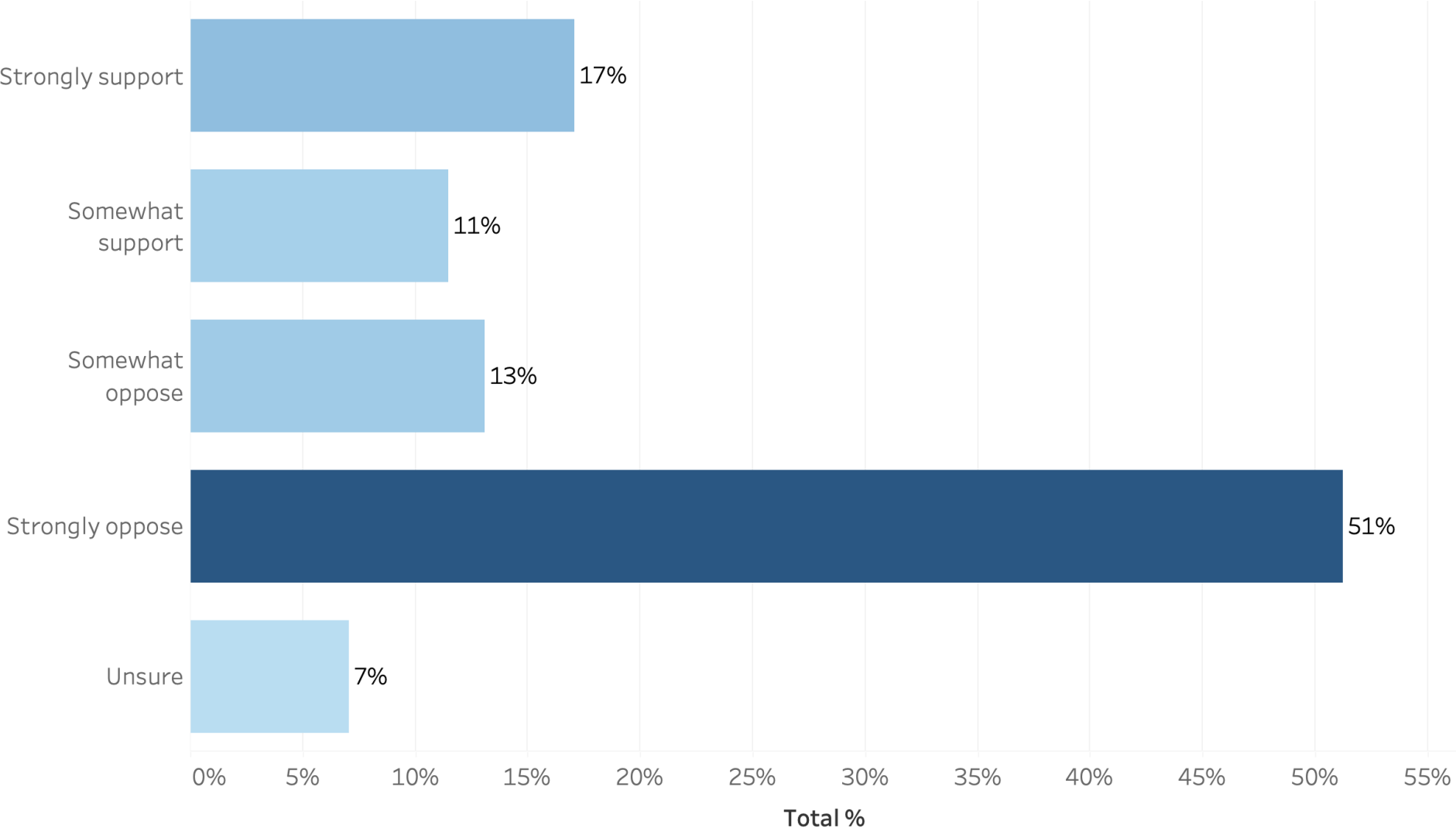
Would you support proposals to expand access to more educational choices within the public education system, including magnet schools, career academic and public charter schools?



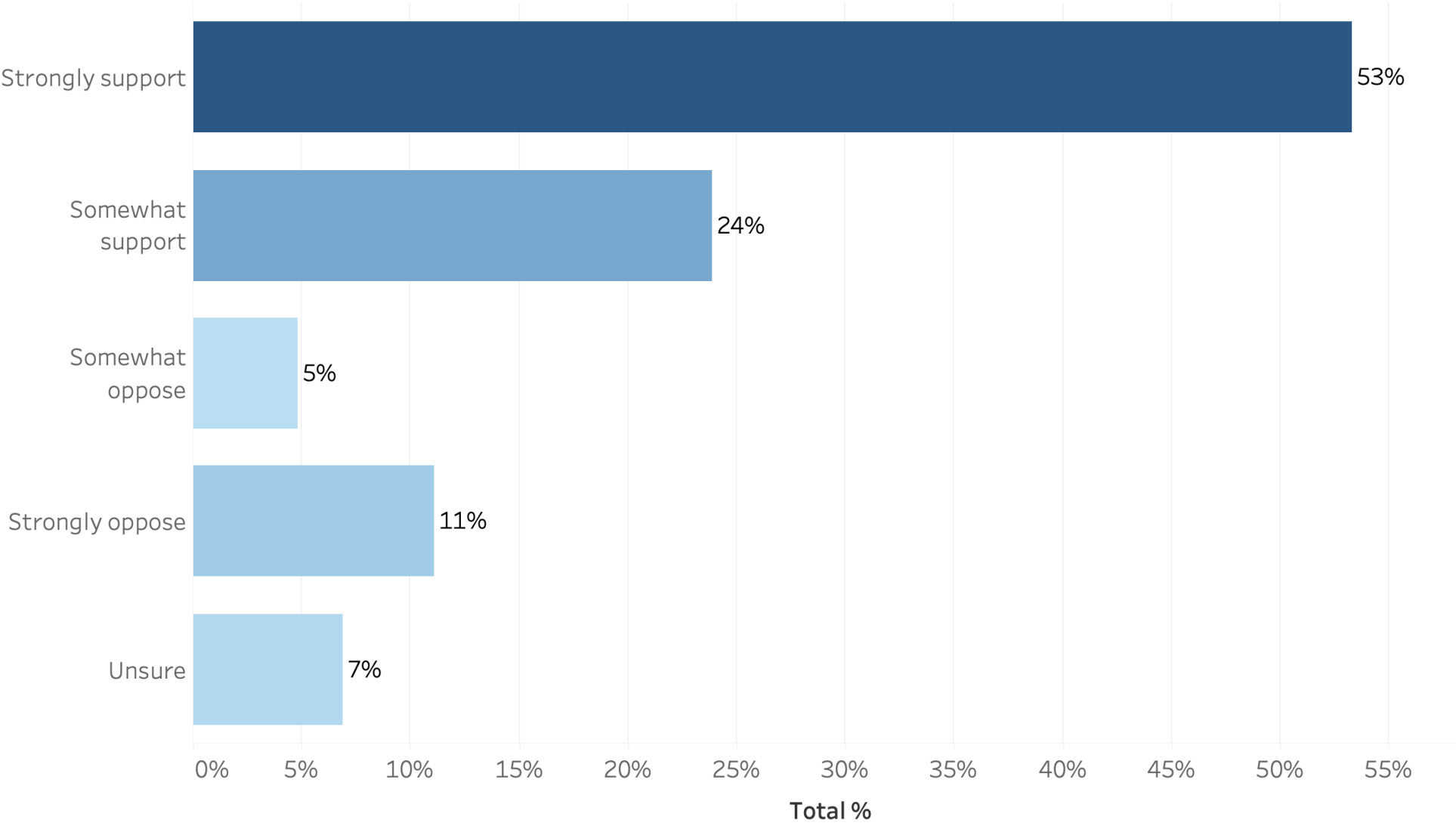

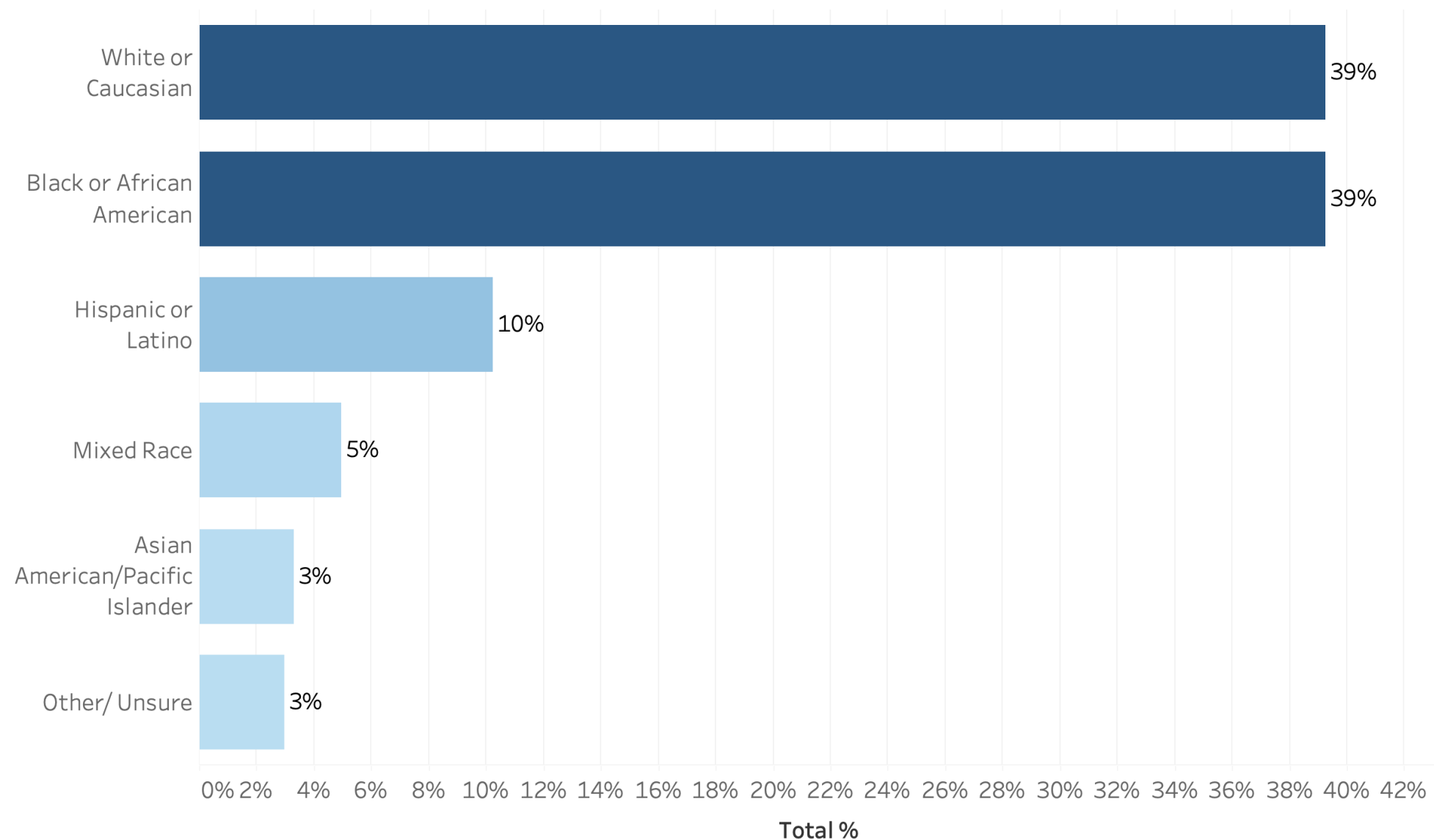
Texas lawmakers are debating whether to divert funding from traditional public and public charter schools to pay for funding for students to attend private and religious schools. Do you support this proposal?
